Parent's Night Out: In an effort to broaden the relationships among the Trinity Parents, we have decided to implement bi-monthly Parent's Night Out events. These are informal “Meet and Greet” social nights intended to provide our parents a place to get together, and enjoy an evening out. Please note that these are NOT fundraising events, just a time and place for members of the Trinity community to get to know one another better. We are currently working with Altruist Brewing Co. in Fiskdale to host our first event.

“Make a Scarecrow, Make a Difference”: At this event, participants will make a life-sized scarecrow for a fee of \$20. Along with making their scarecrow, they get to free admission to our activity-filled Pumpkin Path, along with a fall chrysanthemum or pumpkin to decorate it with. **\$10 is donated to Trinity Catholic Academy.**
