

This month you will read a historical fiction book. Remember your book needs to be approved by me before reading. Please follow the directions below.

- 1. Construct your laptop by gluing the keyboard and screen to a file folder, sturdy construction paper, cardboard, or whatever you have that is stronger than regular paper.
- 2. Then you will write an email to the main character of your story, if your story has more than one main character, please pick one. Your email should be done in complete sentences and include the following;
 - Choose three character traits you noticed from the story (see the attached list for ideas). This will be your first sentence.
 - Pick three different scenes in which the character showed these traits and briefly describe them. This is giving evidence from the story to support your observations. For example, in the story "I Wanna Iguana" in my email to Alex I could say, I think it was very thoughtful of you to offer to buy your new iguana's food.
 - Close your email with your opinion of the character.
- 3. Lastly, decorate the outside of your laptop, is it an apple, mac, or a one of a kind?
- 4. You will also be graded on spelling, grammar, neatness, and overall appearance. Please use erasable pen.
